

# Middle Eastern, European Languages and Culture with Polish

Timetable Previews (2024-25)

Programme: The degree in Middle Eastern, European Languages and Culture (MEELC) gives students a unique opportunity to study the history, culture and one language of the Middle East (Arabic, Hebrew, Turkish) combined with a choice of a European language (French, Spanish, German, Italian, Russian, Polish) and its history and culture. In this course students explore diverse perspectives on Middle Eastern and European societies through a study of history, literature and identity politics.

Polish course content: In the first two years, students focus mainly on developing language skills and learning about main trends in the historical and cultural development of Poland, as well as aspects of contemporary Polish society.

Residence abroad: MEELC students spend their third year at the Jagiellonian University in Kraków.
