Programme: Students study the nature of Europe and the forces that have shaped it through the disciplines of history, history of ideas, political science and sociology. They also develop proficiency in Polish and another modern language (French, German, Italian, Russian, Spanish).

Polish course content: In the first two years, students focus mainly on developing language skills and learning about main trends in the historical and cultural development of Poland, as well as aspects of contemporary Polish society.

Residence abroad: European Studies students spend their third year at the Jagiellonian University in Kraków.
