Note - Students offered a place at Trinity College Dublin may subsequently be asked to provide additional documentation to verify their eligibility for EU Fee status. The documentary evidence to be provided could include the following:

- ❖ Passport.
- ❖ GNIB card.
- ❖ Tax documentation demonstrating residency in the EU/EEA/Switzerland/UK for 3 of the 5 years preceding admission.
- ❖ A letter from the Minister of Justice and Law Reform confirming refugee status, humanitarian leave to remain in the state, or similar permissions to remain in the state.
- ❖ Students who have had periods of residence outside the EU are required to provide documentary evidence for their claim for EU fee status. This evidence must be presented with the application. If required for admission purposes.
