- You should consult the most recent one (updated in February 2024), in particular pp. 14-19:
- Pay particular attention to the storage of your research data which must correspond to what is outlined in the above document (p. 19).

Once you have submitted your application through REAMs, it will be reviewed by two members of the School Research and Ethics Committee. If required, you will receive an email prompting you to make changes to your ethics application based on the recommendations of the reviewers.
