

The Student Life Committee

The Student Life Committee (SLC) is an academic committee reporting to Council. The principal function of the Student Life Committee is to consider, to advise on and to make recommendations on policy and practice relating to student life and student well-being.

1. Terms of reference

The main functions of the Student Life Committee are:

- 1. to initiate discussion, to advise and make recommendations to Council on matters of policy and practice relating to student life and student wellbeing,
- 2. to initiate discussion, to advise and make recommendations to Council in relation to the provision of the services that support undergraduate and postgraduate students,
- 3. to advise and make recommendations on matters referred to it by other committees,
- 4. to advise the Dean of Students in her/his role on such matters as the orientation, retention, progression, wellbeing and personal development of students,
- 5. to assess proposals for policies, significant changes to existing policies, and proposals to discontinue existing policies that support student wellbeing and personal development in all aspects of College life,
- 6. to monitor and review quality assurance and improvement measures in respect of student life,
- 7. to consider on an annual basis proposed changes to the University Calendar in respect of student life and to make recommendations to Council.

2. Membership

The Student Life Committee shall consist of:

- 1. The Dean of Students,
- 2. The Senior Tutor,
- 3. The Students' Union Welfare Officer,
- 4. The President of the Students' Union,
- 5. One member of the Scholars' Committee (or nominee),
- 6. The President of the Graduate Students' Union,
- 7. The Vice-President of the Graduate Students' Union,
- 8. The Convenor of the Chaplains,
- 9. The Director of the Careers Advisory Service,
- 10. The Director of the Student Counselling Services,
- 11. The Director of the College Health Service,
- 12. The Director of Student Services,
- 13. The Director of the College Disability Service,
- 14. The Head of Sport and Recreation,
- 15. The Director of Internationalisation (or nominee),
- 16. The Chair of Dublin University Central Athletic Club (or nominee),
- 17. The Chair of the Central Societies Committee (or nominee),

- 18. The Chair of Trinity Publications (or nominee),
- 19. The Registrar of Chambers,
- 20. The Junior Dean,
- 21. The Warden of Trinity Hall,
- 22. The Transition to Trinity Officer, and
- 23. The Postgraduate Support Officer.

The Chairperson of the Student Life Committee shall be the Dean of Students. An Administrative Officer from the Senior Tutor's Office is permitted to attend and shall act as Secretary to the Student Life Committee.

3. Meetings

The Student Life Committee will meet once a month during the academic term, and report in to Council.
