


Timeline for Consultation & Design Implementation Stages



Where we've got to ...

- 1. Fledgling Vision for Postgraduate Education in Trinity
- 2. Emerging overall ambition for the Programme across 3 Horizons
- 3. Work Plan for Horizon 1 (2022-23)
 - a) input from Work Packages applying a prioritization matrix
 - b) workshop outputs on 06.04.22
 - c) activities already 'in the pipeline'
 - d) 'external' discussions related to institutional ambitions and sectoral pressures
 - e) Starting the data analysis and consultation to inform Horizons 2 and 3
- 4. Immediate steps if Council approve (June-August 2022)
 - a) Specification of resource requirements for H1 Work Programme
 - b) Development of business case to secure funding stream
 - c) Development of detailed implementation plan with owners, timelines and milestones for H1
 - d) Establish a Student Forum to engage with Programme and its Work Packages
- 5. Seek funding approval (September 2022) for H1 Work Programme


