Stethoscope Ceremony

Welcome to the Stethoscope Ceremony, our annual celebration to mark the transition of our Year 3 students into clinical training. Although our students encounter patients from the earliest stages of their course, from this point on their training is largely in clinical environments. They are attached to teams or spend time in specialist hospitals learning the essential skills and knowledge necessary to become a doctor.

Rather than a conventional 'white coat' ceremony, we host the Stethoscope Ceremony for several reasons. Trinity clinicians and graduates were instrumental in pioneering the development and use of the stethoscope. William Stokes, one of our Regius Professors of Medicine and a pioneer in the field of cardiology, wrote the first book in English on the use of the stethoscope when he was still a medical student. His colleague Robert Graves, a founder of the principle that student doctors should be taught at the patient's bedside, popularised its use in clinical practice. Finally, in 1851, Arthur Leared, a graduate of the School, invented the modern binaural stethoscope with two earpieces connected to the bell by rubber tubing.

To us the stethoscope represents centuries of our commitment to clinical teaching and the importance of innovation and adopting new techniques and evidence. It emphasises the importance of bedside skills and, as we tell our students, is used to listen to our patients, which is a fundamental part of becoming a doctor.

As our student doctors take to the wards in the 21st century more often in scrubs than in white coats, they must begin to learn and apply the ethical and professional principles of the profession. To mark this, at the end of the ceremony we ask the students along with their teachers to affirm the Declaration of Geneva. This pledge is the modern successor to the Hippocratic Oath that has been taken by physicians for two and a half thousand years. It highlights the values, ethical principles and professional responsibilities shared by all in the medical profession across the world.

AS A MEMBER OF THE MEDICAL PROFESSION:

I SOLEMNLY PLEDGE to dedicate my life to the service of humanity;

THE HEALTH AND WELL-BEING OF MY PATIENT will be my first consideration;

I WILL RESPECT the autonomy and dignity of my patient;

I WILL MAINTAIN the utmost respect for human life;

I WILL NOT PERMIT considerations of age, disease or disability, creed, ethnic origin, gender, nationality, political affiliation, race, sexual orientation, social standing, or any other factor to intervene between my duty and my patient; I WILL RESPECT the secrets that are confided in me, even after the patient has died;

I WILL PRACTISE my profession with conscience and dignity and in accordance with good medical practice;

I WILL FOSTER the honour and noble traditions of the medical profession;

I WILL GIVE to my teachers, colleagues, and students the respect and gratitude that is their due;

I WILL SHARE my medical knowledge for the benefit of the patient and the advancement of healthcare;

I WILL ATTEND TO my own health, well-being, and abilities in order to provide care of the highest standard;

I WILL NOT USE my medical knowledge to violate human rights and civil liberties, even under threat;

I MAKE THESE PROMISES solemnly, freely, and upon my honour.
