### Introduction to General Nursing:

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be awarded a B.Sc. (Cur.) General Nursing from the University of Dublin. They will be also eligible to apply for entry onto the General division of the Register of Nurses and Midwives maintained by the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland. The course consists of theory and practice in caring for patients within the hospital and community settings. General nurses are key members of the healthcare team, providing for the physical, psychological and social wellbeing of patients with acute or chronic physical illness.

### Venues for Learning:

**Theory:** School of Nursing & Midwifery, D'Olier Street; Trinity Centre for Health Sciences, St James's Hospital; main campus of Trinity College.

**Practice:** The linked Health Service Providers are Tallaght University Hospital and St James's Hospital and most practice placements will occur on these sites. Students become employees of one of the Health Service Providers during their internship in the final year of the course

### The application process:

All applications for this course must go through the Central Applications Office (CAO).
