Bootcamp FAQ for ADA University Students

1. What is the bootcamp about, and what can I expect to learn?

The startup bootcamp is organized by ADA University and Trinity College Dublin in partnership with OpenIncubator and sponsored by ADA Foundation, Pasha Holding, and the Innovation and Digital Development Agency of Azerbaijan. This bootcamp helps ADA students develop their ideas at the concept level, supporting them in building MVPs (Minimum Viable Products) and gaining essential entrepreneurial skills. The program spans two months in a hybrid format, concluding with an in-person Demo Day in Azerbaijan.

2. Who is eligible to apply for the bootcamp?

All undergraduate and postgraduate students at ADA University are eligible. Teams should have at least two members, ideally with one member from a business background and one from a technical background. Solo founders may be accepted in certain cases.

3. How do I apply for the bootcamp, and what is the deadline?
