NO RSLT RPYR	No result - Repeat Year		Where no result is available due to disciplinary issue a student is to repeat the year. Results are not published.	Repeat the year
ABS NO PERM	Absent Without Permission - Exclude		Exclude a student due their attendance record. Usually paired with module grade(s) of AB , "absent". The record is not rolled forward and the student gets cut off from College IT systems.	Contact your tutor for advice
FAIL EXCLUDE	Fail - Exclude		A student is to be excluded from College according to regulations set out in <i>Calendar</i> .	Contact your tutor for advice
QF EXCLUDE	Fail - Exclude		To exclude a student who has achieved a 'Qualified Fail' result. Usually paired with module grade(s) of QF .	Contact your tutor for advice
F1 EXCLUDE	F1 Exclude		Exclude a UG student earning an F1 grade and who may not repeat either the same year a second time or two sequential years.	Contact your tutor for advice
F2 EXCLUDE	F2 Exclude		Exclude a UG student earning an F2 grade and who may not repeat either the same year a second time or two sequential years.	Contact your tutor for advice
WITHDRAWN	Withdrawn		Student has officially withdrawn from College
