

SCS Student Advisory Board Recruitment Process 2024-5

All Student Advisory Board (SAB) volunteers must be recruited and trained according to Trinity's Dignity and Respect and EDI Policies.

SAB Volunteers must be registered students for the current academic year, and available to participate in the SAB for a minimum of 4-5 hours per month for a at least one academic year. They are recruited through a range of emails (these may be to all students or via specific societies), via outreach events, over social media and by existing SAB members (students and staff).

Online applications are reviewed, and applicants may be invited to interview. Interviews are conducted according to the SAB Interview Guidelines. Places are offered based on application/interview quality and ensuring a broad representation of the student body within the volunteer cohort.

Those who are selected, will proceed to SAB training. Those who complete required training will then be appointed to the SAB. Volunteers who fail to attend training without due notice, or who fail to complete training will not be confirmed as SAB members.
