PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

The Postgraduate Certificate in Innovation and Enterprise Development aims to empower students to translate their creative and innovative ideas into products, services and policies.

You will learn the fundamentals of innovation, idea generation, opportunity recognition and enterprise. You will acquire the tools needed to be innovative and entrepreneurial in your approach to problem solving and how to address societal issues on national and international levels. Our students will experience and engage with entrepreneurs, business leaders and industry mentors through both classroom and online learning.

Duration: 20 weeks

Days: Tuesdays and Thursdays + 4 Saturdays

Delivery: In- person, Part-time

The course will be delivered in a blended format, a mixture of online and in-person delivery. An emphasis is placed on experiential and action-oriented learning via a combination of masterclasses, workshops and project-based activities.

COURSE CONTENT

The part-time course is comprised of three modules, totaling 30 ECTS and delivered over a 5-month period commencing in January 2025.

TEAMWORK & ASSESSMENT

Students will learn to collaborate effectively within a diverse multidisciplinary environment. Teams will be comprised of people with diverse yet complementary skills who will be tasked with proposing creative solutions to project brief.
