How to make an appointment to register your immigration permission?

- All non-EU/EEA/Swiss/UK students must register your immigration permission within 90 days of arrival
- You can now book and adjust their registration appointments directly through the Digital Contact Centre (DCC) self-service portal: https://portal.irishimmigration.ie/en/
- Registration Office(Immigration Service Delivery) is located at: 13-14 Burgh Quay, Dublin 2, D02 XK70.

Advice for attending your ISD appointment in person

What do you need to bring?

- Valid Passport
- Proof of Registration*
- Proof of Fees Paid*
- Proof of finances: €7,000 for courses resulting in residence of greater than 8 months, €585 per month or €4,680 (in total) for courses resulting in residence of 8 months or less. Note, this ONLY applies to students from Non-visa required countries.
- Proof of financial support (if applicable, with scholarship letter).
- Proof of Health Insurance, policy document is required.
- €300 Fee (No cash accepted. Credit card or debit card)





^{*}Proof of registration and proof of fees paid are in the same letter and can be generated and printed from your student portal (my.tcd.ie)

Immigration Card (IRP)

- Referred to as Stamp 2 or Stamp 2A (for one-semester students).
- You should receive your IRP card by post within 10 working days.
- If you haven't received it after 10 working days, please log in to the online portal (the same one used for booking your appointment) and submit a query.
- When you receive the IRP card, please check that all the details are correct.
- A valid IRP card allows unlimited travel to Ireland and is essential for applying for other visas.

* Make sure to confirm the right address at your appointment





Printing the Proof of Registration Letter


- Log on to my.tcd.ie portal
- Click on the 'Registration tab' for options of letters to print
- Click on 'Confirmation of Registration'
- Go to 'Intray' on the home tab.
- Your letter will be in your 'New Intray' or 'All intray messages'
- Click 'Proof of Registration' to open and print the file



Entry visas for other countries

If you are planning to take a trip outside of Ireland:

- Check the visa requirements of the country you are going to
- Ensure you allow sufficient time to apply for your visa
- Check on your destination before you travel: https://www.dfa.ie/travel/




Schengen Visa

- 27 European countries, make sure you apply to the right embassy
- Check requirements with the Embassy of the country you're applying to travel to

Common documents required (original & copy):

- Passport & Passport photo
- Application form
- IRP card valid for at least 3 months after your trip
- Travel medical insurance
- Proof of registration
- Bookings (e.g. flight and accommodation)
- Application fee etc.

UK Visa: standard visitor visa

Application process:

- Complete online form and answer all questions
- Pay the fee and make an appointment with VFS visa centre
- Attend appointment for fingerprint and photo
- Wait for the visa

Documents needed (suggested):

- A valid Passport
- IRP card
- Bank statement
- Checklist

If you are a visa-required national for the UK, it's crucial to note that obtaining a UK visa is mandatory for entering **Northern Ireland**.

Apply for an ETA

The fastest way to apply is using the UK ETA app.

Download on the App Store Download on Google Play

If you cannot use the app, You can apply <u>online</u>.

Notes:

- Your ETA lasts for 2 years. You can travel to the UK as many times as you want during that time.
- You are required to obtain ETA for entering Northern Ireland.

Changes to your studies



How to open a bank account



3. Bank Account Opening Requirements

Banking Options:

- Allied Irish Bank (AIB): www.aib.ie
- Bank of Ireland (BOI): www.boi.ie
- Money Jar: https://moneyjar.world/ (Student Onboarding TCD code 89610)

Some documents that may be required to open a bank account:

- Proof of address in Ireland: Letter from Academic Registry
- 2. Proof of ID: Passport
- 3. Bank Statement from your home country
- 4. Other documents depending on each bank and students' nationality



4. Rights to work as a non-EU student

- Only students attending a full degree full-time course and in possession of an Irish Residence Permit card are entitled to take up casual employment
- Note: Single semester study abroad Non-EU students are not permitted to work in Ireland.





Health Insurance



5. Health Insurance

All non-EU students are required to have private medical insurance

This should provide emergency accident cover and should cover any period of hospitalisation




Trinity's Health Insurance (Irish Life)

6. Safety



What is SafeZone?

This Trinity App increases the security and safety of students and staff while in a Trinity location. It provides immediate access to Trinity resources to provide assistance in cases of emergencies or when an alert is raised.

What is SafeZone used for?

SafeZone enables you to raise alerts (by pressing the emergency button on the App) or seek assistance when onsite in Trinity. Once an alert is raised, the user's location is shared with our security team who then respond. The App allows users to check-in for specific time periods and if they do not check-out within that period, an alert is automatically sent to security.

Further functionality will be delivered over the coming months, including sending Trinity notifications to our SafeZone registered students and staff.

How do I access SafeZone?

Just download the SafeZone app from the iOS or Android App stores, enter your TCD username and password, complete the registration form and you are good to go. You can opt to check in automatically (recommended) or manually check-in when required.
