


Living in Dublin

Safety

- Overall a safe city
- Mind your belongings
- Pay attention to your surroundings, particularly at ATMs and entering your apartment/house
- Avoid walking alone at night
- Irish Police: An Garda Síochána or 'the Guards'
- In an emergency call 112 or 999 (on campus call 01 896
 1999)
- Local Garda Station Pearse Street 01 666 9000 (nonemergency)



Medical

- Hospital care: Health insurance is required for non-EU students. EU students should present their EHIC to receive hospital care
- Even with insurance or an EHIC, there is a charge to attend
 A&E or to call out an ambulance
- GP practices/dentists/physiotherapists etc will charge per visit






