Dublin City

- Founded in 988 (allegedly)
- Dubh Linn – Black Pool
 - Baile Atha Cliath – Town of the hurdled ford
- Small, compact city with large suburbs (we call it 'Town')
- Divided into north and southside by the River Liffey
