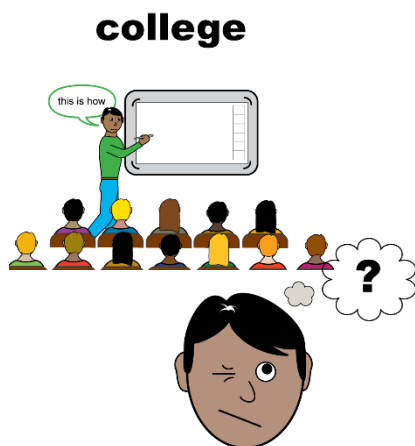

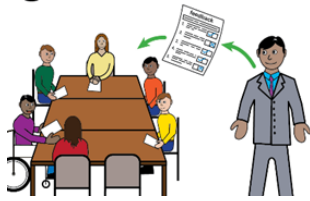

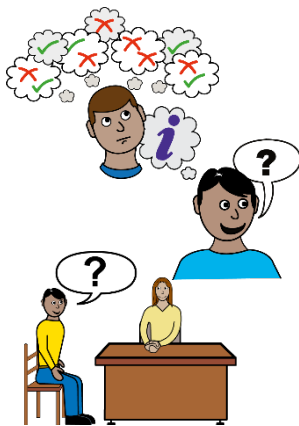
The article was written by Barbara Ringwood, Jennifer Banks and Michael Shevlin.
