General Principles for the Capstone Project within the Common Architecture:

- 1) Students will undertake one Capstone project in the Senior Sophister year.
- 2) The Capstone project will be valued at 20 ECTS.
- 3) Where a student is following the Single Honours Degree Pathway for their Sophister years, they will complete a Capstone project in the subject of the Single Honours award.
- 4) Where a student is following the Major with Minor Degree Pathway for their Sophister years, they will complete a Capstone project in the Major subject. Where feasible or appropriate, elements of the minor subject may contribute to the design or delivery of the Capstone project.
- 5) Where a student is following a Joint Honours Degree Pathway in their Sophister years:
 - a) Students will advise which of their two subjects they wish to complete their Capstone in as part of a process run by the UCAO
- 6) Module pre-requisites for Capstone projects may exist.
 - a) Disciplines/Programmes of Study should normally inform students of these pre-requisites as part of provision of advice to students ahead of the year the pre-requisites are delivered in.
 - b) Disciplines should normally advise the UCAO of all pre-requisite requirements.
 - c) Students are responsible for engaging with information provided from Disciplines and/or Programmes of Study and ensuring they are aware of any pre-requisites for Capstone projects. Students are responsible for module selection and as such are responsible for ensuring they meet the requirements of their Capstone.
