Please note the following:

- This list of Open Modules is indicative and correct at the time of publication.
- Open modules are normally offered on a first come, first serve basis and a module may not be available to you in SITS for any number of reasons, including cancellation, a module reaching its capacity limit, or a timetable change that renders it incompatible with your programme.
- We would recommend that you prepare to select a number of Open Modules that may be of interest to you while being mindful of any prerequisites. The maximum number of credits you may take in Open Modules in SF year is 15 ECTS.
- When selecting Open Modules we would recommend that you be mindful of the information in the 'Timetabling Block' column if you are selecting two modules in the same block that are also in the same 'Period of Delivery' then these modules are likely to clash and you may be required to select a different module from an alternative block/period of delivery.
- We would recommend that you consult the document '<u>Balancing your Open Modules and Trinity Electives SF Students on a Joint Honours Pathway'</u>. This will assist you in making choices which ensure you achieve a balanced number of credits (30 ECTS) in each semester. You will not be able to complete online module enrolment without doing so.
