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# Trinity disAbility Service Facts

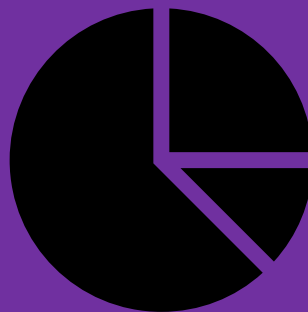
(2022-2023)

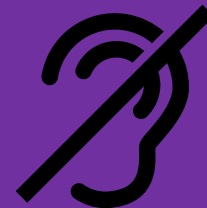

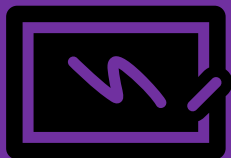
